SUBJECT: Changes Affecting Class "DI" and Class "RI" Licensees

This is to inform you of two changes that will soon affect Class "DI" and Class "RI" Instructors.

First, the Division will begin issuing the durable PVC-card licenses with the holographic image of the state seal and the licensee's photograph on the front to Class "DI" and Class "RI" Instructors upon initial application and renewal. These are the same cards that are issued to all other licensees under Chapter 493, Florida Statutes.

Second, the Division will begin requiring all applicants for a Class "DI" and "RI" license to submit a set of fingerprints and a \$42 fingerprint card-processing fee along with the other materials required upon initial application. Again, this is in keeping with standard operating procedures for all other Chapter 493 licensees.

These changes will be implemented effective March 15, 2005.
